June 28, 1919 - May 2, 2008

Agnes Elizabeth Wilson, 88, a native of Durant, Oklahoma and long time area resident, died Friday, May 2, 2008. Mrs. Wilson was born June 28, 1919, the second of four children born to Walter and Alford Hart Johnson. She would move to Goldthwaite, Texas as a child with the Johnson family where she attended and graduated from school. After graduation, she attended Southern Nazarene University before becoming engaged and marrying the late MSgt. Carmen Wilson, USAF (ret). She would support and be a faithful military wife for the next forty-two years, until the time of his death in 1988. Mrs. Wilson was a faithful servant of God. She was a life-long member of the Church of the Nazarene, and was active with several congregations, including South Oak Cliff, River Oaks in the Ft. Worth area, and most recently, Trinity Church of the Nazarene in Duncanville, where she was active until her health began to deteriorate. She loved teaching Sunday School, teaching the Single Adult (College and Career) Class for many years. Her sacrifices to the church were honored and acknowledged when she was awarded "Mother of the Year" at Trinity Church of the Nazarene in Duncanville. She was always a Godly mother, and took great pride and joy in her two children, five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. She leaves behind her son, Rev. Jerry Wilson and his wife Judi of Wylie; daughter, Cheryl Adams and her husband, Rev.
