



Alvin Anderson Swindell

January 11, 1934 - September 21, 2010

Alvin Anderson Swindell, a native of Alba, Texas, died September 21, 2010 in Irving, Texas after an extended illness. Alvin was born on January 11, 1934, the youngest of 8 children and the son of the late Whitney Anderson Swindell and the late Ursela Williams. He attended school in Sherman, graduating from Sherman High School in 1952. After his graduating, he would join the US Army for 2 years.
