October 1, 1928 - September 28, 2011

Angel Gutierrez Gomez, age 82 died peacefully Wednesday evening, in Dallas, Texas surrounded by his family, 3 days before his 83rd birthday. He was born October 1, 1928 in Melissa, Texas.
