When I told her I wanted to follow my husband to Mexico and get rid of basically everything I owned she told me "Follow your heart!". I learned all I know from you Ma' and I want to thank you for making me a strong woman. I believe I can accomplish what I set my mind to because of what you have shown me over the years. I love you for that! Now I am here with my two girls teaching them to be strong just like you taught me.
