

## Charles "Bobby" Miller

Charles Robert Miller (known to family and friends as Bobby), 70, passed away peacefully on Friday, January 23, 2026, in Grand Prairie, Texas, following a brief illness.

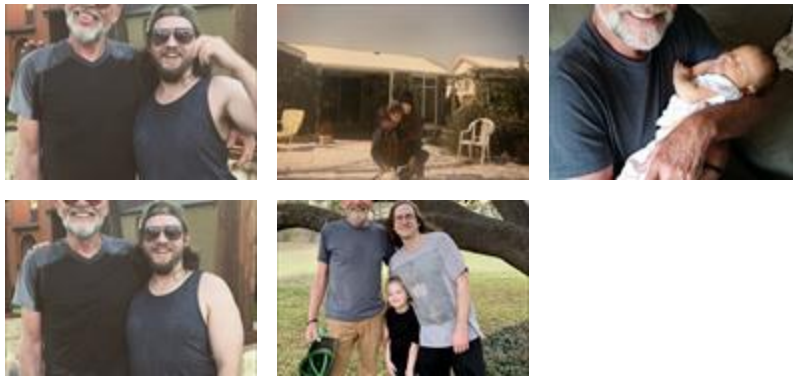

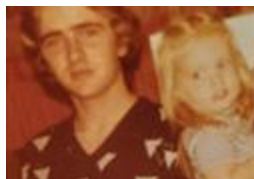

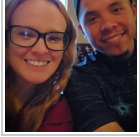
