



Chester Elmo Lassiter

Chester Elmo Lassiter, 92, a native of Duncan, Oklahoma and long-time resident of Grand Prairie, died on Monday, January 8, 2018 in Mansfield, Texas.

It had been something he always wanted to do. He would work for Wells Fargo and several apartment complexes before completely retiring.

contributed to his long life.

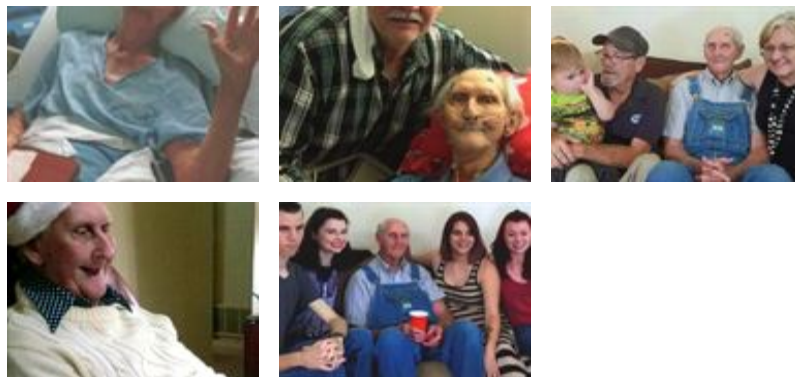
