Christopher Andrew "C.K." Kirchmeyer, beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend, left us peacefully on January 19, 2026, at the age of 53. Born on August 6, 1972, in Dallas, Texas, Christopher was the youngest of five children and was raised in Mesquite, Texas, where he graduated from North Mesquite High School in 1990. His life was marked by a generous spirit, a commitment to service, and a love for his family and community.

Christopher loved to sing. He appeared many times over the years at The Garland Opry, Johnnie High's Country Music Revue, and other venues throughout the Dallas-Fort Worth area. He regularly performed the National Anthem at Lone Star Park.
