David Isaac Cantu, 44, faithful servant of Christ, passed away unexpectedly on December 21, 2022 at a local hospital.

David Cantu was born on April 6, 1978 on the Navajo Indian Reservation in Shiprock, New Mexico. He started his education in Farmington, New Mexico. In 1986 his family moved to Bartlesville, Oklahoma where he attended school, graduating from Bartlesville High School in 1996.

He attended Texas A & M in College Station, Texas before transferring and graduating from Oklahoma State University in Tulsa, Oklahoma where he received his Bachelor's Degree with a major in International Business and a minor in Marketing. For the past ten years he worked for Allstate Insurance Company as a Claims Support Agent Consultant but his true passion was photography.

David spent the majority of his time serving at The Life Church in Dallas where he was a member. He was a talented musician and served on the music team, playing the organ and keyboards as well as serving on the

photography team. His work can be viewed on the church website with the majority of the photos displayed as a clear reflection of his work.
