David DeLeon, 71, loving husband, father, grandfather, brother and faithful friend, passed away on Monday, September 19, 2022 at the Dallas Veteran's hospital.

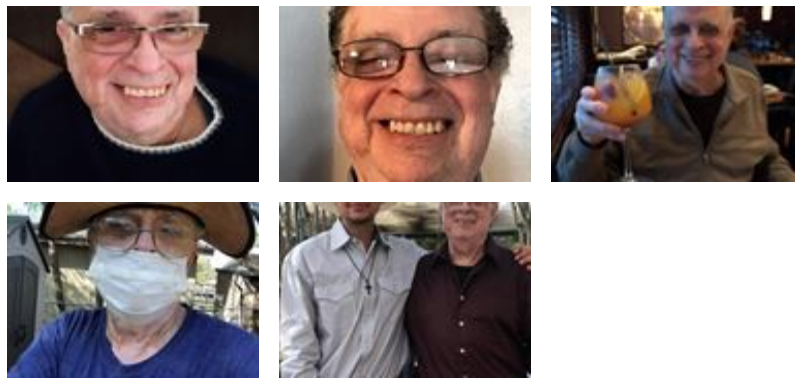
