David Glenn Williams, 67, husband, father, grandfather, son and brother, died Monday, November 8, 2010 at a care facility in Arlington, Texas after a lengthy illness. David was born May 16, 1943 in Dallas, Texas, the third of eight children born to the late Bennie Len Williams and Mildred Lucille McCord Williams.
