We even went to weight watchers together when they were meeting at the bowling alley. She always told me how proud she was of my weight loss (I lost 133 pounds). 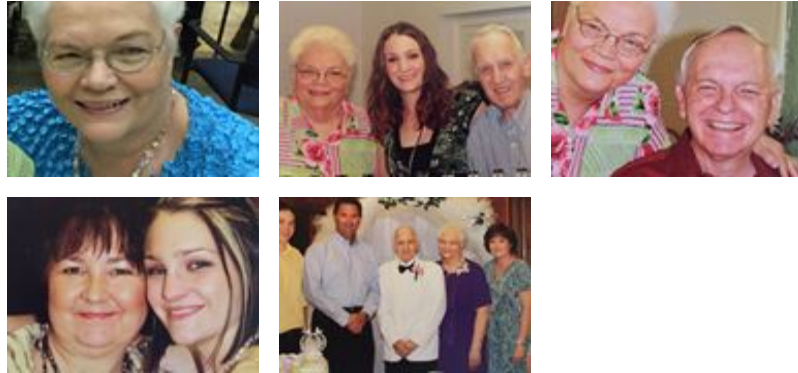
