Couglas Scott Calhoon, 41, died Sunday, August 9, 2009 at an Arlington hospital. Scott was born October 3, 1967 in Dallas, Texas. He would attend schools in Beaver, Oklahoma, where he graduated from Beaver High School. While in school, Scott was involved in many extra curricular activities, including football, golf and tennis. Scott enjoyed laughing, and is remembered as being the class clown. He could keep everyone amused, but was also very tenderhearted, befriending those considered underdogs. He is remembered as a happy young man with a toothpick on the side of his mouth. He was a popular among his peers, even attending proms at four different schools. His mother joked, "you may as well buy a tuxedo." He loved animals, especially his German Shepperd, Kaiser. He was a gifted athlete, enjoyed the outdoors and loved riding his bicycle. After graduation from high school, he attended North Western Oklahoma State University. In 1988, Scott was involved in an accident that resulted in his moving to Amarillo for treatment, where he would reside until moving to Grand Prairie in 2005. Time will never dim the happy memories He is survived by his mother, Nancy Harris and her husband Arlyn; sisters, Stephanie Kennedy and Danielle Lamirand; and an extended family, all who loved him dearly.
