Earl Lee Middleton, 82, a native of Muskogee, Oklahoma, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, Sept. 12, 2013.

Earl was the only son of the late Mamie Lee Middleton, born on August 28, 1931. His family would move to Texas where he would attend and graduate from high school. He would meet Delmarie "Del" Jackson, and on June 20, 1959 they would begin fifty-four years of life together.
