



Edward Riley Gwynn

Edward Riley Gwynn, 83, a native of Tacoma Park, MD., and long-time resident of Grand Prairie, died Friday, Jan. 11, 2013 in Grapevine, TX. Edward was the 4th of 5 children born to the late Andrew Riley Gwynn and the late Gwendolyn Thomas Gwynn. He was a graduate of Brigham Young University, Duke University School of Divinity, and Georgetown University School of Law. During the Korean War, he would serve as a US Naval Chaplain. He was a lifelong member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.
