Elizabeth "Beth" Ann Moore, 54, loving wife, mother and friend, completed her earthly journey on Monday, September 19, 2016 in Dallas, Texas.

Beth was born on December 6, 1961 in Little Rock, Arkansas, the oldest of 3 children and only daughter born to the late Charles Edward Moore and the late Roberta Cook Martin Moore. She would attend school in Arkansas, attending both McClennan and Mills High Schools . She would enroll at the University of Arkansas, where she would eventually meet Jay Moore.

They would marry on August 2, 1986 in Springdale, Arkansas. In 1986, they would move to Texas, originally living in Greenville and Dallas before buying their first home in Grand Prairie. While in Grand Prairie, the family would become members of Holland Road Fellowship, formerly Grand Prairie Bible Church. Beth would remain a faithful member, active with various groups within the church community.

At the age of 5, Beth was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. She would continue to receive treatment until the 9th grade, establishing lasting

friendships with the nurses and medical staff. These experiences would lead her calling as a nurse and caretaker, always caring and nurturing.

She loved the color, purple and watching Disney movies. Always young at heart, she would occasionally recall ballet lessons she learned as a little girl. The family would enjoy watching her, still trying to perform some of her remembered skills. She was an avid scrapbooker, collecting many photographs of children and family.

She is survived by her husband of thirty years, Jay Kelley Moore; son, Jon Moore; daughter, Abby Moore; brothers, Jeff Moore and his wife Jeanette and Glen Moore.
