



Ellen J. (Weathers) Ault

June 15, 1925 - March 6, 2014

Ellen Jacqueline Weathers Ault, 88, a long time resident of Grand Prairie and current resident of Arlington, died on Thursday, March 8, 2014 following a brief illness.

In her golden years, Ellen loved to knit and travel. After moving to Matlock Place in Arlington, she would serve as Secretary for the Social Group and was also involved in the Red Hat Society.

She was preceded in death by parents; Carthul Eugene Butler and Inez Russell (Miller); brothers, John Ely, Duane Butler; husbands; Arthur Wayne Weathers and Jack R. Ault.
