Gordon Earl Gaspard Sr., 60, a native of Corpus Christi, Texas, former resident of El Dorado, Arkansas and resident of Arlington, Texas, died unexpectedly on Wednesday, December 28, 2011. Gordon was born on September 27, 1951, the son of James Gerard Gaspard and Doris Friend Gaspard. He attended and graduated from school in El Dorado. Shortly after his graduation, he would enlist in the U.S. Navy, serving four years, mostly on submarines.
