November 3, 1924 - March 8, 2010

Harvey Walter Markham, 85, a retired plumber and life long resident of Grand Prairie, died Monday, March 8, 2010 in a Dallas hospital. Harvey W. Markham was born November 3, 1924, the fifth of nine children born to the late James Walter Markham and the late Emma Florence Langston Markham. Harvey attended and graduated from school in Grand Prairie, and began working in the family business, Markham shoes. Harvey would later become a Code Inspector for the City of Grand Prairie and would also serve as Maintenance Superintendent for the Grand Prairie Independent School District.
