



Horacio Cardenas

August 19, 1934 - April 18, 2004

Cardenas, Rev. Horacio, 69, died Sunday, April 18, 2004 at his home after a lengthy illness. Rev. Cardenas was born August 19, 1934 in Laredo. He was veteran of the US Army and of the Korean war. After serving in the army, he attended and graduated from Howard Payne University and later, Southwestern Theological Seminary. Rev. Cardenas pastored churches in Dallas, Missouri and San Antonio, finally becoming a chaplain at Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas, where her retired after 23 years of service.
