Jerry Wayne Warren, a beloved son, father, brother, grandfather, and friend, passed away peacefully on May 11, 2025, at the age of 78. Born on October 16, 1946, in Fort Worth, Texas, Jerry was the second of three children in his family. He grew up in Grand Prairie, where he attended Grand Prairie High School. As a proud Grand Prairie Gopher, he made a name for himself as an exceptional running back and track star earning high honors and a reputation that would stay with him throughout his life.

After graduating High School, Jerry attended Cameron College in Oklahoma on a football scholarship. He was employed with Dallas Police Department from 1968-76 working in patrol and later transferring to the motorcycle unit in the department's traffic division. After leaving the Dallas Police Department he worked in sales for many years until he founded Warren Products, Inc., an industrial hardware supply company. Through hard work, determination, and an unwavering spirit, Jerry built this venture into a successful enterprise. His leadership and business acumen were respected in the industry by his peers, and he took great pride in the legacy he created.

He enjoyed attending the Texas High School football playoffs every year for decades with family and friends. From the old Texas Stadium which he loved dearly, to the new ATT Stadium that he never liked, he would always bring his hot chocolate Thermos and 10X Binoculars where he witnessed many great football games and future NFL players. These pastimes reflected his love for the outdoors and the joy he found in sharing these moments with family and friends.

He is survived by his son, Brian Warren, and his wife, Cindy Warren; his son, Joey Warren, and his wife, Heather Warren; Jerry also leaves behind six cherished grandchildren: Alex, Brandon, Meaghan Cox husband Tanner Cox, Faith, Hannah, and Jacob, along with his great-grandchild, Wyatt Cox.
