Jerry Don Cantrell, 54, loving husband, son, brother and nephew, died Tuesday, October 28, 2008 in Arlington after a year long struggle with pancreatic cancer. Jerry was born December 30, 1953 in Dallas, Texas, the oldest of three children born to Donald Ross Cantrell and the late Lee Eunice Boyd Cantrell. He attended schools in Dallas, including Adamson High School, eventually graduating from Grand Prairie High School where he was active in the I.C.T. program. Jerry was a hard worker, starting his career immediately after graduation. He began working for Texas Motor Coach as a mechanic, moving to Continental Bus Lines and eventually Greyhound where he worked for more than 20 years. He would later transfer to Ft. Worth, working as a the night shift supervisor for The T Bus Service until his illness limited his ability. He was a superb diesel mechanic, often able to diagnose problems by sound only. Jerry enjoyed taking cruises, enjoying a chance to go new places and see new sights. He was a thoughtful man, always thinking of others before himself. He loved to watch movies, and had the ability to remember things that he would read for long periods of time. His was a member of The Korean American First Baptist Church in Arlington.
