Jerry Max Salzar, 88, a native of Henryetta, Oklahoma, died on Saturday, July 23, 2011 at his home in Grand Prairie. Mr. Salzar was born on December 30, 1922, the 4th of 6 children born to the late James Max Salzar and the late Alice Mae Fronabarger. Jerry left school early to join the US Army Air Corp., opting to join so he would not be in the infantry. His military experience would eventually lead him to working with the Corp of Engineers. After WWII, he would return to the states, working for the defense industry in Grand Prairie. While there, he would meet Mary Baxter. They would marry on December 19, 1953. Grand Prairie would become their home, where they would raise 4 children. Eventually, Mr. Salzar would work for Domac Plastics, finally retiring in 1990. He was an avid football fan, following the Dallas Cowboys and Oklahoma Sooners. He loved being with his family, especially family cookouts. He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Mary Baxter Salzar; children, Tommy Salzar and his wife Marilyn, Mike Salzar, Sharon Mathews and her husband Thomas, Diane Salzar; 12 grandchildren; 10 great-grandchildren, all with which he had a loving relationship.
