Jonathan was born on June 10, 1986 in Newport Beach, California. He graduated from Carrollton Christian Academy and went on to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree in History from Baylor University in 2008. Jonathan was employed in the health care field as a Center Operations Director at Concentra, where he managed an Occupational Health and Urgent Care Center.

Jonathan was known for his magnetic personality and keen wit. He loved his family and friends deeply. If you knew him, you also know that Jonathan always did everything big, full throttle. He was taken from us far too early.

Jonathan is survived by his parents, John and Pam Crews, his brother and sister, Christian and Danielle (“Dani”), his grandparents Diane Christianson, Jacqueline Crews, and Michael and Jody Christianson, as well as by numerous aunts, uncles and cousins and his beloved dog pal Ulysses.

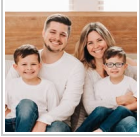
