April 29, 1946 - November 5, 2017

Josef Boruvka, a native of the Republic of Czechoslovakia and long-time resident of Lancaster, entered into eternal life on Sunday, November 5, 2017 following a lengthy illness.

He would initially move to Dallas from New York. Shortly thereafter, he moved to Maryland where he worked as a skilled baker and chef. His culinary skills excelled to the point where he was able to cook for several US Presidents.

Josef would attend the University Texas at Arlington where he would major in German with a minor in Spanish Education. His education would allow him to teach in the Lancaster ISD several years, teaching German and Spanish.

He is survived by his wife of 28 years, Roberta Kincaid Boruvka; son, Samuel Boruvka; sisters, Mana Suba and Jana Macharackova.

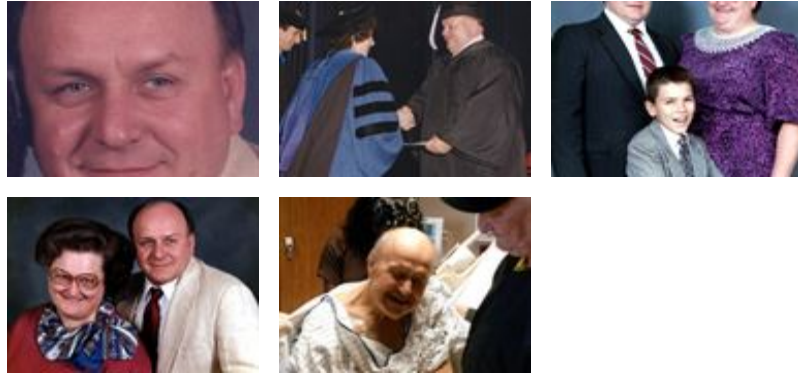
