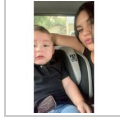

“It is hard to put into words how Juan in some way touch every one that knew him, but personally for me he was not just a co-worker, he was a friend, family in some ways like an older brother. I met Juan nearly 30 years ago while he was working for Team Controls at Texas Instruments DMOS6, we’ve worked together ever since until last year when he retired from Prime Controls after 16 years. When I first met Juan I always wondered why is this guy so happy all the time, he’s working his butt off and still he’s singing, whistling, cracking jokes & messing with some of his coworkers. In some ways you could say that he was good at making stuff up on the fly, I remembered one day he came in singing a Willy Nelson song “On The Road Again” with his own lyrics that read “I’m On The Roll Again” I told him that he was singing it wrong and his response was, No Joe “I’m On The Roll Again” that’s my song.

Juan was a craftsman and could fix almost anything from mechanical, tubing, plumbing, electrical, welding, carpentry, you name he could do it. He would take the time to teach others his craft (tubing bending) but didn’t like to teach those that were not willing to listen, he knew who those people were, and he would tell them.

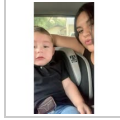

Also he could operate almost any kind of construction equipment, he would say I haven’t used a Bulldozer but how hard can it be to operate one, just give me about an hour on it and I’ll have it figured out.

But Juan wasn’t always about work, he would talk to me about his family and some of the things he did with them over the weekend, although Juan didn’t show a whole lot of emotion at times his top priority was his family, he was always making sure they were taken care of, his wife, sons, daughters, & grandchildren. You could tell he was very proud of what he had accomplished, raising a family the best way he knew how.

Juan was always friendly, courteous, and respectful to everyone he

met and at times very funny, you will be dearly missed by all of us that knew you, "rest in peace my friend, until we meet again".
