



## Juanita Stone

May 24, 1922 - September 8, 2009

Juanita Stone, 87, a native of Hollister, Oklahoma, and long time resident of Grand Prairie, died Tuesday, September 8, 2009 at her home surrounded by her family. Juanita Stone was born May 24, 1922, the fourth of seven children born to the late Samuel Monroe Harmon and the late Bessie May Cox Harmon. After attending school in Oklahoma, she would meet and marry the late Eugene Franklin Stone in 1939, with whom she would share the next 51 years of life, until the time of his death in December of 1990. Juanita was a life long member of the Assembly of God Church, attending Lakeland Heights Assembly of God Church, now Radiant Life Assembly of God. She was a faithful Christian, loyal first to her God, second to her family and children. She is remembered as never meeting a stranger.
