It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Kathryn Ann Fletcher, a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister, and dedicated member of the community. Kathryn was born in Detroit, Michigan on November 8, 1949, daughter of the late James Alvin Blain and the late Mary Louise Perez Blain, before her family moved to Dallas when she was 12 years old. 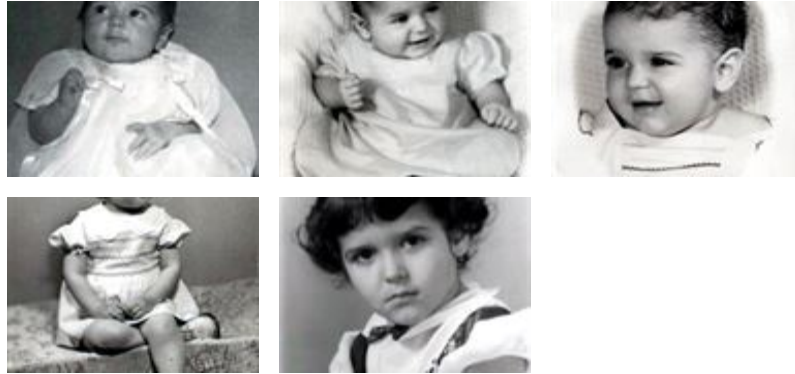
