Lee Ann Feuerbacher, 58, died on Friday, December 12, 2014 at a local hospital in Arlington, Texas.

Lee Ann was born on July 20, 1956 in Irving, Texas. She was one of two Children born to Diana Parker and Howard Hamilton. Lee Ann was a lifelong resident of Irving, and graduated from Irving High School in 1974, later to graduate with a BA from Baylor University in 1978.
