Louise Boyd Huff Hudspeth (everyone's beloved "Granny"), 92, passed away Wednesday, September 9, 2020 in San Antonio, TX.

She was born in Dawson, Georgia on April 11, 1928 to the late Harold A. Boyd and Sarah Gandy Boyd.

Louise married Fred L. Huff in October of 1946 in Midland, Texas and raised her family there. She worked at Texaco as a Texas Railroad Commission Clerk for 35 years.

In 1971, she married Russ Hudspeth, then after retirement they spent many glorious years in Port Isabel, TX fishing and RVing. After Russ' stroke, they returned to Midland where they continued their retirement travels throughout the United States.

After Russ passed away in 2003, Louise moved to Grand Prairie to live with her daughter Sandi. She became active at The Summit, First Baptist Church, Grand Prairie Woman's Club and the Branding Irons Committee of the Grand Prairie Chamber of Commerce. Louise led the Monday night Texas Hold 'Em Poker Group at the Summit for many years, and won the Grand Champion Trophy in 2006.

In her golden years, she moved into Atria Senior Living and spent her final days at Inspiration Hills Rehabilitation Center in San Antonio under the care of her granddaughter, Jenny.

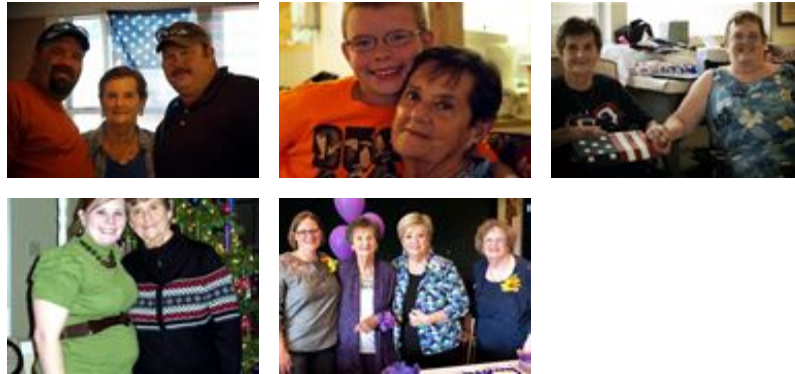
