



## Louise La Verne Peeler

August 11, 1928 - October 29, 2013

Louise La Verne Peeler, 85, passed from this life to life eternal on Tuesday evening, Oct. 29, 2013 at a local care center.

Louise was born of August 11, 1928, the oldest of 3 children born to the late William Donald Dyer and the late Jewel Ellen McMillian Freeman in Brown County near Winchel, Texas. She was raised near and attended schools in Brownwood, graduating from Brownwood High School and attending college at Howard Payne College, now Howard Payne University.

While there, she would meet the late Earl W. Peeler, and would become his wife for the next 51 years. After their marriage, they would move to Alpine, Texas so that Earl could complete his college, earning a degree in education. Shortly thereafter, they would live in various places, including Big Springs, Itaska, Robstown, Pampa, and finally, in 1960, Irving where Earl taught schools.

In 1983, they both would retire and move to Grand Prairie, residing there at the time of his death in 1998. She would stay until 2004 when her health would begin to decline, resulting in her relocation to be near children.

Louise was gifted at crocheting and sewing. She took delight in presenting fellow residents at the care center with birthday and special occasion gifts,

often hand sewn pillows. Her children recall the many her preparing special meals and the talent she possessed as a cook. She would occasionally enjoy a fishing trip with family or just having the opportunity to share time with her children and grandchildren.

She was a life member of the Church of Christ, attending S. MacArthur Church of Christ and was a member of the the Order of Eastern Star, Grand Prairie Chapter 219.
