



## Louis Everett Triplett US Navy (ret)

August 10, 1943 - February 15, 2009

Louis Everett Triplett, 65, a retired US Naval Master Chief, died Sunday, February 15, 2009 at his home in Grand Prairie after two year struggle with pancreatic cancer. Louis was born August 10, 1943, the son of the late Lee Eugene Triplett and Ruby Nau Triplett. He retired from the Navy after 24 years, 9 of those serving as a recruiting officer.
