Marguerite Addison Groves English passed away at age 97 on January 8, 2012, at the Wesleyan at Scenic Nursing Home in Georgetown, Texas. Born Sept. 13, 1914, in Dallas, she is survived by son James Robert Groves and his wife, Linda, of Lancaster, PA; daughter Georgianna Morgan Springer and her husband, Bill, of Georgetown, TX; five grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, numerous nieces and nephews, and many other relatives and friends. She was predeceased by her husband, Lt. Col. George Robert Groves., Jr., who died in 1953; her second husband, Major Jesse David English, Jr., who died in 1988; brothers Dallas Addison and Carl Addison; identical twin sister Elizabeth Cobb Henson; and grandson James Robert Groves Jr. The daughter of William and Emma Addison, Marguerite graduated from Sunset High School in Dallas, where her siblings, first husband, and children also graduated, and attended Baylor University. Music was an important facet of her life, beginning with violin performances with her twin sister and continuing with piano, organ, and active church choir singing. As an Army wife she travelled widely throughout the country, and particularly enjoyed living in post-World War II Japan for three years. She served as Assistant to the Minister at Rosemont Christian Church in Dallas, and later as a placement officer at the Texas Employment Commission. In these positions, Marguerite's outgoing and engaging personality helped her gain and maintain lifetime friendships.
