Michael Evan Mauney, 76, a life-long resident of Dallas, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 1, 2017 at a local hospital.

Michael was born on November 5, 1940, the son of the late Jack Evan Mauney and the late Elin Esther Thurman Mauney in Dallas. He would attend schools in Dallas, and be a member of the first graduating class of Bryan Adams High School in 1959.
