Louis' outstanding service to his country was in many capacities. He was an Army Special Forces Green Beret, serving 3 tours of duty with the Medcorp in Vietnam. Louis helped to save hundreds of lives, and those he couldn't, he stayed with comforting these brave men and women until they passed away. This is a true hero! He never thought of himself as such, and never talked about the times spent in Vietnam. Louis was given the following commendations: National Defense Service Medal, Army Commendation, Meritorious Unit Commendation/Parachutist Badge, Over Seas Service Bars, Good Conduct Medal, Army Service Ribbons, and Over Seas Service Ribbons. Louis was also part of Medical Corpsmen, Clinical Specialist, NCO Academy, Chemical Biological/Radiological NCO and Airborne School. Louis gave 20 years to the Army and his country, retiring in 1984. At that time, he decided he needed to do more. He went back to schools, graduating from Park College in El Paso, earning a B.A in Psychology. He then started a long, successful career in the Nursing Home business. There, once again, Louis gave comfort to so very many seniors. He often talked about how rewarding

his job was and never did realize how he was respected and loved by those seniors he touched. Other honors include Eagle Scout, a Lifetime member of Kiwanis International and a graduate of Grand Prairie High School.
