Pansee Pickens was born in Vivian, Louisiana on September 1, 1933, the daughter of the late Jim Pickens and the late Maude Burns Pickens. She would marry the late Arnold M. Cox on September 4, 1954. Over the next thirteen years, they would have four children. Together, they would own and operate four used car dealerships in Grand Prairie.

Arnold's untimely death in 1967 would leave Pansee a widow at thirty-two years old. She relied on her faith and strong work ethic, which she developed as a teenager, to provide for her young family.

Always striving to better herself, Pansee would become a real estate agent, then a broker in Grand Prairie. She was proud to play a part in helping

families own their own home. She also worked for Omnitrition International as an accounting and payroll specialist.

Pansee volunteered in many civic organizations and in younger years, worked the polls for local elections. When her children were in school she served in the PTA, as well as numerous committees at her church. She was also involved in the Grand Prairie Rotary Club.
