Paul David Driggers, 70, husband, father, grandfather and friend, of Red Oak, TX, passed away on Sunday, May 8, 2011 following a brief illness. Paul Driggers was born on October 3, 1940, in Dallas, Texas, the youngest of four children born to the late Thalmar D. Driggers and the late Susie Winferd McGowan Driggers. Paul would join the US Army, serving for three years as a military policeman, specializing in canine enforcement. After his service, he would come back to Dallas, starting to work for Morton's Foods.
