May 7, 1926 - August 14, 2013

Pearl House Gregg, 87, of Grand Prairie, entered into life eternal surrounded by family in the early hours of August 14, 2013.

Pearl was born on May 7, 1926 in Memphis, Texas, the oldest of 4 children and the only daughter born to the late Adron Cliff Miller and the late Fannie McBee Miller. The family would move often, living in Oklahoma and Texas, working in agriculture and the farming industry. They would have a unique family of gifted musicians, all learning to play the guitar and sing. During her last days of life, the most precious family moments would be spent in morning devotion time with singing and prayer.

As a young lady, she would marry the late Arthur House. They would live in west Texas, primarily the Lubbock area, before moving to Grand Prairie 1971. Their family would soon be blessed with grandchildren to whom she would lovingly be known simply as "Granny".

"Granny" would be the ultimate model for any grandmother. She loved her family unconditionally, and would continually hold them up in prayer. In 1992, her beloved Arthur would precede her in death.

Some 6 years later, Granny would remarry, finding again love, friendship and companionship with Rev. Harlan Gregg. She would become a "preachers

wife" for the next 14 years.

Pearl was a gifted quilter and long-time member of the First United Pentecostal Church in Grand Prairie.
