Peggie Deane Moore, 78, a native of Athens, Texas and resident of Grand Prairie, died Friday morning, April 18, 2008. Peggie D. Moore was born March 25, 1930, the oldest of twin daughters born to Paul D. and Mamie Ethel Stogner Clanton. She moved to Grand Prairie with her family in 1934 where she attended Grand Prairie High School before transferring and graduating from Southwestern High School in Ennis. Mrs. Moore retired from The Texas Department of Health and Human services, working for more than thirty-five years, most recently as manager. She was extremely active with the Council for the Aged and Disabled, serving as councilman until 2007 when her health began to deteriorate.
