Raul Cesar Trevino, 61, a native of Corpus Christi, died on Tuesday, May 22, 2012 in Irving, Texas. Raul was born on January 10, 1951, the son of the late Raul Molina Trevino and the late Daisy Vela Trevino. He would attend schools in Corpus Christi, graduating from Moody High School.
