



Raymond Dewitt Worsham

February 17, 1940 - January 22, 2015

Raymond Dewitt Worsham, 74, resident of Grand Prairie, died on Thursday, January 22, 2015 in Fort Worth, Texas.

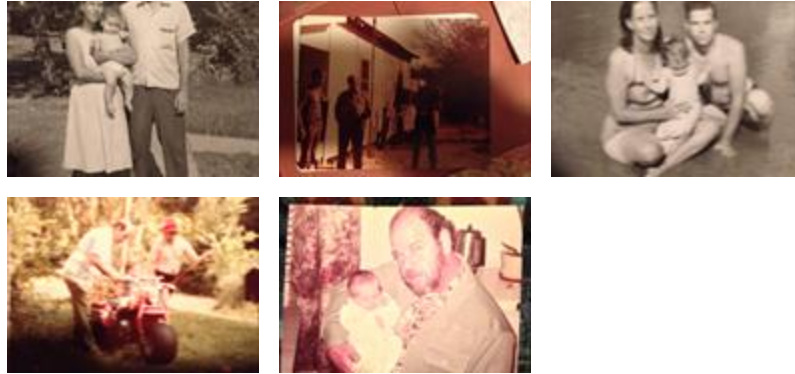

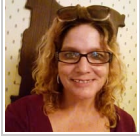
