Raymond Howard Tittle, 83, a retired mechanical engineer, died Saturday, November 8, 2008 in Dallas, Texas. Raymond Tittle was born October 22, 1925 in Dallas County. He was the youngest of three children born to Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Tittle. Raymond joined the US Army during World War II, misrepresenting his age to the government in order to enlist. He was initially assigned to the infantry, but eventually became the driver for a colonel. After his military experience, Raymond developed into a self-taught engineer with an uncanny ability to design and build. His employment included M & M Engineering in Grand Prairie until eventually working for Texas Instruments. He would remain there for more than 35 years until the time of his retirement in 1990. Raymond could design and build anything. He had a special interest of working on cars, but his real passion was for design. He was a faithful member of the Forum Terrace Church of Christ. Survivors include his wife of 17 years, Annie Sessions Tittle; sons, James, Dennis, David and Don; 6 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren.
