Former Phoenix resident Renee Ogle (néé Bartoli), 68, of Grand Prairie, Texas, passed away on April 15, 2024 after an extended illness. She is survived by her husband of 30 years, Robert Ogle; brother Jay Bartoli of Ocala, Florida; sister Paula Jones of Prescott, Arizona; and brother Daniel Bartoli of Phoenix, Arizona. Renee simply wasn't capable of meanness or cruelty.

She was a wonderful wife and best friend to Robert, and embraced the meaning and importance of family. Renee helped loved ones through stressful and life-changing situations on numerous occasions, typically without being asked. She always seemed to know the right thing to do, and did it quietly

without calling any attention to herself.

Her personal philosophy can be summed up in her favorite quote, from author Edward Everett Hale:

"I am only one, but still I am one. I cannot do everything, but still I can do something. And because I cannot do everything, I will not refuse to do the something that I can do."

Now she belongs to God. Go now and rest in peace, darling.
