Ronald Harold Dudick, 80, long-time resident of Grand Prairie and current resident of Waxahachie, entered into eternal life on Thursday, January 17, 2019 at a local hospital.

Ron had a heart for serving others. One of his greatest joys was leading Hot Dogs and Hope, a charitable organization that provided Christian fellowship and warm food for the homeless. His peers selected him for an "Outstanding Service Award" due to his dedication and tireless work.

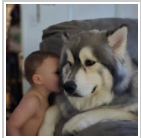
