Stephen "Steve" Cody Cox, 66, loving brother and uncle, entered into life eternal on Friday, Nov. 14, 2014 at a local hospital in Dallas following a lengthy battle with cancer.

Steve was born on July 10, 1948, the son of the late Gordon Cox Jr. and the late Jean Dale Mayo Cox in Dallas, Texas. He would attend school in the Carrollton area, graduating from R.L. Turner High School.

Shortly after high school, he would join the US Army, serving as a medic in Korea during the Vietnam War era. During his illness, he never lost his sense of humor. He was gregarious and fun to be around. He had an easy way around ladies, and his flirty ways could make them comfortable. He helped his family as caregiver to his mother, 2 grandmothers and an aunt. He often joked he was in charge of "DDTs" (dogs, dishes and trash).

He is survived by his sister, Cheryl Vale and her husband John; nephews, Shawn Vale, Christopher Vale, Matthew Vale and a niece, Heather Vale Robertson.
