He amassed 230 hours of volunteer service around the community, finding that the more he helped others, the better he felt. Upon graduation, Stewart accepted a scholarship to Texas Christian University, where he majored in Marketing and minored in Japanese. There he was active in the Brothers Under Christ (BUCS) Fraternity. He had been accepted into the Neeley School of Business and had been participating in career and networking conferences. He planned to graduate in the summer. His ultimate career goal was a marketing position with a company having a presence in Japan, where he could put his

fascination with all things Japanese to good use.
