Theo Perry Blaylock, 92, a native of Henry County, Indiana, died Sunday, May 16, 2010 in Garland, Texas. Ms. Blaylock was born on February 16, 1918 in Henry County, Texas, the daughter of the late Elmer Perry and Elnora Lannard Perry. After her graduation, Ms. Blaylock joined the US Army in Indianapolis, Indiana where she served as an ambulance driver from 1942-1944.
