Troy Hinton, 85, a native of Dallas County and long-time resident of Grand Prairie, entered into eternal life on Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at home surrounded by many friends and family members.

Troy loved football. If there was a game on television, he would watch. He was especially a Dallas Cowboys fan. He loved to take care of his yard, proud that his grass was the greenest in the neighborhood, and his flowers were always in bloom.

More than anything, he loved his Savior. He was a faithful Christian, a long-time member of Eighth Street Baptist Church in Grand Prairie.

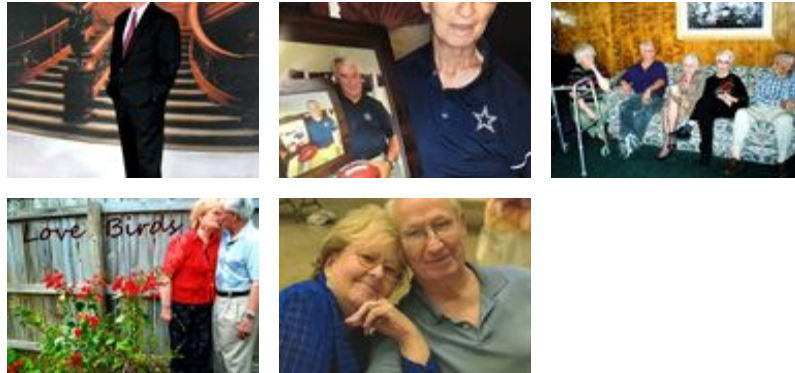
