Wade Cameron Jones III, 55, a native of Fort Pierce, Florida, and former resident of Los Angeles, died Monday, May 21, 2007 in Arlington, Texas. Mr. Jones was born March 14, 1952 to the late Wade C. Jones II and Mildred Williams Jones. Wade was a long-time resident of California, attending schools in Sunland. He later would attend University of La Verne and College of the Canyons, receiving his M.B.A. and graduating summa cum laude.
