



Waynoka Rose Ward

June 30, 1927 - September 19, 2015

Rose "Meme" Ward, 88, a long-time resident of Grand Prairie, passed from this life unexpectedly on Saturday afternoon, September 19, 2015 in Arlington, Texas.

Rose Renfrow Ward was born on June 30, 1927 in Sedan, New Mexico, the daughter of the late Robert Porter Renfrow and the late Rose Adams Renfrow. After graduation from Draughon Business College, she would marry the late Billy Gene Ward, move to Grand Prairie and give birth to a daughter, Kelly. She would become a widow 10 years later, but would continue to raise her daughter in Grand Prairie.

For a period of time, she would be an employee of Army Air Force Exchange Service working as a Vehicle Management Assistant. She would eventually leave AAFES to become a full-time grandmother, babysitting after school.

Rose would remain active up until the time of her death. She was an avid line dancer, dancing regularly since 2001 with her best friend and chauffeur, Yvonne Moore. She would dance at the Pantego Lions Club on Wednesday,

the Grand Prairie Summit on Thursday and the Senior Dance in Arlington on Friday. Her motto became, "if you don't use it, you lose it!"

She is survived by her daughter, Kelly Brewer; grandchildren, Andrew Hein and his spouse Diana, Brittany Rose Hein and her fiance' Keith Edwards, Kasey Brewer and his spouse Amanda Gonzalez; 5 great-grandchildren, Lia, Alex, Emily Rose, Amani, Romeo; siblings, Tommy R. Renfrow, Veda Ringo, Reva Jean Jones and Lee Renfrow.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by her siblings, Ted Renfrow and Robert "Bob" Renfrow.
