William Ronald Coombs Jr., 75, a native and long-time resident of Pittsburgh, PA, passed away on Monday morning, October 3, 2022 at his home in Fort Worth.

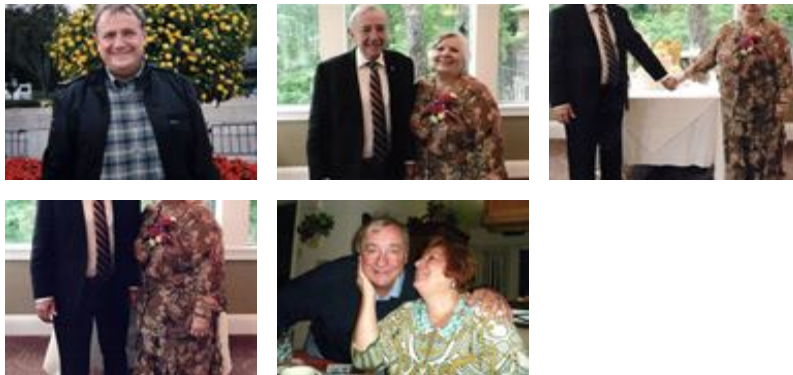
